

2010 SkillsUSA Maryland Cosmetology Competition

NOTE : NO HUMAN MODELS THIS YEAR, CONTESTANTS ARE TO BRING A MANNIQUEN TO USE FOR THIER DAY TIME & EVENING STYLES.

Remember contestants must bring 4 pictures of the **finished daytime** style consisting of **front view, each side view and back view**.

Please forward this information to the cosmetology teacher and student contestant(s).

Please review this information with your competitors so that they will arrive at the contest site well- prepared.

Again this year, non-water soluble styling products are **not permitted**. If used the contestant will be disqualified and their school will be asked to reimburse me for the purchase of a replacement mannequin (\$35.00).

2010 SkillsUSA Maryland Cosmetology Competition

Contestant Requirements:

Contestants must be current members of SkillsUSA Maryland and have pre-qualified for the state contest via SkillsUSA Maryland Regional competitions.

Objective:

Competitors will be expected to duplicate required tasks and skills on mannequins following proctor's instructions.

Preparation for contest:

- Contestant must have **four** clear photos (front, left side, right side, and back views) of daytime roller set **style** to be demonstrated on contestants own mannequin.

Note: if contestant does not provide proper pictures then there will be a deduction of 50% (-40 points) of the possible points for the daytime styling skills (set & comb-out).

Skills to be judged:

- Duplicate a specific hair cut and thermal style on a mannequin,
- Duplicate a daytime roller set and style on mannequin from a picture the contestant provides
- Change Daytime style into an evening style
- Demonstrate the creation of a fantasy style on a provided long hair mannequin
- Demonstrate all necessary safety and sanitation requirements
- Demonstrate the ability to accurately respond to a technical question

Dress code:

Contestant - white SkillsUSA uniform or School uniform, safety shoes(closed toe, leather top, thick sole)

- Points will be deducted for improper dress
- **Note:** all personal & school names must be covered.

Supplies provided:

- Work station & styling chair with electricity hair dryers (Mannequin Box Dryer)
- Shampoo sinks
- New mannequin & stand (students may keep upon completion of contest)
- 24" mannequin (must be returned to contest chair)

Scoring Rubric:

Skills to be performed :

• Hair cut	40 pts	40 minutes
• Long hair fantasy style	40 pts	40 minutes
• Thermal styling	40 pts	30 minutes
• Daytime style	40 pts	30 minutes
• Evening styling	40 pts	30 minutes
• Verbal	<u>10 pts</u>	1 minute
Total	250 pts	

Scoring:

- 250 point scale per contestant per judge.
- Students will receive points according to their skill
- Each skill performed has 10 subcategories showing students what skills are expected during demonstration. The subcategories are found in contest descriptions will be rated as follows;
 - 4pts – Exceeds requirements for subcategory
 - 3pts – Executes neatly and meets all requirements for subcategory
 - 2pts – Executes with some difficulty and meets some of the requirements for the subcategory
 - 1pt – Not executed neatly, meets minimal requirements for the subcategory
 - 0 pts – Meets no requirements for subcategory
- Judges will individually rank each student by the completed skill performed, and a point score.

Note: Possible point deductions

- Up to 10 points may be deducted from the total score if stylist is improperly dressed
- Up to 10 points may be deducted from the total score for unsanitary kit, unorganized station set up, and missing necessary tools or supplies, including blood spill kit
- Up to 10 points may be deducted from the total score if work area is left unclean at end of competition.
- 30 points per judge will be deducted from the total score if contestant does not provide proper pictures for the daytime styling.

Skill Criteria for Cosmetology Competition

Hair Cut & Thermal style

- Contestants will be expected to duplicate on a contest provided mannequin a specific haircut and thermal style provided by contest chairperson.
- Electric cutting tools are not permitted during this contest.
- Contestants are expected to use blow dryer and curling irons (stove or electric) tools for the styling portion of the contest.
- The thermal styling is to be performed on the contest provided mannequin which contestant has demonstrated the required cut regardless of cut completion.
- This years style has been chosen from the “Milady’s 28 Styles” copyright 1992,
- **style #24, pg 48 & 49**
- A Picture is included in this packet.
- Contestants will be given a copy of the diagram and instructions for the hair cut during the contest.

For the Hair cut contestants are expected to demonstrate the following:

(40 points-40 minutes) - NO electric cutting tools are permitted during this contest.

- Drape
- Correct perimeter guidelines
- Correct interior guidelines
- Correct lengths as shown on diagram
- Correctly blended
- Proper use of tools
- Contestant’s work area remains neat and orderly
- Followed all necessary sanitation requirements
- Completed hair cut in time allotted
- Contestant followed instructions

For the Thermal styling contestants are expected to demonstrate the following:

(40 points-30 minutes)

- Drape
- Uses clean sanitary tools
- Blow drying techniques support intended style shown in picture
- Curling iron techniques support intended style shown in picture
- Finishes style looks the picture of intended style
- Style is a finished and balanced
- Contestant’s work area remains neat and orderly
- Followed all necessary sanitation requirements
- Completed thermal style in time allotted
- Contestant followed instructions

Daytime Set & Style

- Contestant will be expected to duplicate a daytime roller set and style, of their choice, on their personal mannequin
- The contestant must **provide a set of 4 pictures of their pre-chosen style** for judges to view during the contest.
- Pictures must be of the finished style and include a front view, back view, left side view, and right side view.
- Electrical tool are **not** permitted during this portion of the contest.
- Hair ornaments or hair pieces are **not** permitted during this portion of the contest

**For the Daytime roller set contestants are expected to demonstrate the following:
(40 points-30 minutes) – No end papers permitted**

- Drape
- Styling set of 4 pictures are provided
- Uses clean sanitary tools and equipment
- Set is predominately rollers
- Rollers, pincurls, and shapings are secure, neat and placed properly
- Set supports intended style shown in picture
- Contestant's work area remains neat and orderly
- Followed all necessary sanitation requirements
- Completed roller set in time allotted
- Contestant followed instructions

** judges can assign up to 10 extra points for style difficulty and technique

**For the Daytime comb out contestants are expected to demonstrate the following:
(40 points-30 minutes) - No electrical tool are permitted**

- Drape
- Style pictures are present
- Looks like the picture of intended style
- Hair is neatly arranged
- Style is finished
- Style shows balance
- Contestant's work area remains neat and orderly
- Followed all necessary sanitation requirements
- Completed comb-out in time allotted
- Contestant followed instructions

** judges can assign up to 10 extra points for style difficulty and technique

Evening Style Change

- Contestant will be expected to change the Daytime style into an evening style with out resetting the mannequinn's hair.
- **Any** styling tool is permitted at this time.
- Hair ornaments and pieces of hair **may** be used to enhance the evening style.

**For the Evening style conversion contestants are expected to demonstrate the following:
(40 points-30 minutes)**

- Drape
- Speed
- Creativeness
- Style is different from daytime style
- Hair is neatly arranged
- Hair shows balance
- Contestant's work area remains neat and orderly
- Followed all necessary sanitation requirements
- Completed comb-out in time allotted
- Contestant followed instructions

** judges can assign up to 10 extra points for style difficulty and technique

Long Hair Fantasy Style

- Contestant will be expected to create a fantasy style on a 24" provided mannequin
- **Any** styling tool is permitted at this time.
- Hair ornaments and pieces of hair **are not permitted for this style.**
- Sorry no color gel is permitted
- NOTE :**non-water soluble styling wax is not permitted**

**For the long hair fantasy style contestants are expected to demonstrate the following:
(40 points-40 minutes)**

- Drape
- Speed
- Creativeness
- Creative use of tools
- Hair is neatly arranged
- Hair shows balance
- Contestant's work area remains neat and orderly
- Followed all necessary sanitation requirements
- Completed style in time allotted
- Contestant followed instructions

** judges can assign up to 10 extra points for style difficulty and technique

Verbal Presentation

- Contestant will be expected to verbally respond to a technical question
- Maximum answer time allotted is 1 minute

**For the verbal presentation contestants are expected to demonstrate the following:
(10 points 1 minute each contestant)**

- Quick response to question
- Accuracy of answer
- Clarity of information
- Demonstrates self control and self confidence
- Completed answer in time allotted or less
- Contestant followed instructions

**Clean up: contestants are expected to clean up
(5 min. - deduction of 5 points if not done)**

- Followed all sanitation requirements
- Returned all supplies to proper place
- Disposed of all trash in receptacle
- Sanitized station when done
- Completed procedures in time allotted
- Contestant followed instructions
