Item #2: Virtual FLC Student Preparation – Create SkillsUSA CONNECT Account!

After you've registered your students for the Virtual FLC, make sure they begin working on their pre-work for the conference. All participants will need to

create a SkillsUSA CONNECT account (if they haven't already) using the same email address used for the conference registration. This will ensure that

students can access/complete the Framework Essential Element Assessment (before the FLC) and then access the conference on November 5, 2020.

Build Profile in SkillsUSA CONNECT

Participants will need to create an account in SkillsUSA CONNECT, as this is where the conference will be hosted.

Step Two (BY REGISTRATION DEADLINE – October 22)

Complete Essential Element Assessment in SkillsUSA CONNECT

Step Three (ONE WEEK BEFORE FLC – By October 29)

Complete Framework Certification Module in SkillsUSA ABSORB

Step Four (ONE WEEK BEFORE FLC – By October 29)

Complete SkillsUSA Statesman Quiz in SkillsUSA ABSORB
