Item #1: Low Participation Contest Instructions

If you registered students/teams in contests with less than three (3) participating chapters (“low participation”) you received an email titled “Two School Contest...,” or email title is single contest name (ie. Action Skills, Community Action Project, Firefighting, etc.). Following SkillsUSA Maryland State Championship protocol, low participation contests are decided locally and contestant/team rankings (1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place) must be forwarded to the state director as soon as confirmed, **and no later than Friday, April 23, 2021.**

Regardless of contest participation status (less than 3 chapters / 3 or more chapters) all competing students must **upload resumes, complete SkillsUSA online Knowledge test and technical tests (for skilled and technical contests only)**. Student online test access codes have already been sent to chapter advisors. If you have not received an email from Sherry Kratz, Customer Service, TFI, please contact state director ASAP. Online testing deadline is **Friday, April 9, 2021.**

Item #2: **ACTION ITEM!** All State Championship Competitors Must Upload Resumes and Take Knowledge Test
