Item #1: Resume Submission and Online Testing Clarification

**Resume upload and testing instructions/deadlines for “low participation contests”** (contests with less than 3 schools registered to compete). Students must upload resumes, complete SkillsUSA Professional Development (SkillsUSA knowledge) test, and contest-aligned technical tests no later than **Friday, April 23, 2021, 6pm.**

**Resume upload and testing instructions/deadlines for all other contests – see attached MS Excel spreadsheet** listing 24 contests and 41 online technical tests. Students must upload resumes, complete SkillsUSA Professional Development (SkillsUSA knowledge) test, and contest-aligned technical tests no later than **Friday, April 9, 2021, 6pm.** April 9th deadline is for students competing in the 24 listed contests only! (see attached spreadsheet)

Exceptions for **Medical Math (4/20), Medical Terminology (4/20) and Related Technical Math (4/21)** tests. Students will take these tests on scheduled days.
